By letter dated May 29, 2020, you have requested copies of certain documents pursuant to the Maryland Public Information Act (hereinafter, "PIA"), Md. Ann. Code, State Govt. Art., GP § 4-101 through § 4-601 et seq.

Incident reports, any/all recordings, notes, documents, witness statements, or any releasable information associated with the following investigations: 19-84800, 19-119371, 19-63289 and 20-21442

You will find the incident reports enclosed. However, sociological information has been redacted. This is information that "identifies an individual including an individual's address, driver's license number or any other identification number, medical or disability information, name, photograph or computer generated image, Social Security number, or telephone number."

Such sociological information may be redacted in accordance with GP § 4-330 sociological information — if the official custodian has adopted rules or regulation that define sociological information for purposes of this subsection, a custodian shall deny inspection of the part of a public record that contains sociological information, in accordance with the rules or regulations.

In addition to sociological information, you will find all medical references redacted as well. Under GP § 4-329 Medical or Psychological Information a custodian shall deny inspection of the part of a public record that contains (1) medical or psychological information about an individual.

Juvenile information has also been redacted along with parents to keep the identity sealed, this is due to SG §7-303 of the Education Article, is which a police record concerning a child is confidential. Its contents may not be divulged, by subpoena or otherwise, except by order of the court upon good cause shown.

Due to the reporting being done "anonymously", the names of those individuals has been redacted under GP § 4-351(b)(7), however, the "person of interest" is entitled to inspect investigatory records of which he/she is the subject unless production would endanger the life or physical safety of an individual. As well as the redaction, their specific written notes are being denied release. Their notes have been incorporated into the report.

Pursuant to GP § 4-361, you are entitled to an administrative review of a decision to deny access. If requested, such review will be conducted in accordance with GP § 4-361(b) and the hearing regulations of the agency published at COMAR 00.00.01. You may also seek judicial review under GP § 4-362
